VILLAGE OF GREENWICH VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATION NUMBER 6

SECTION 1

ENABLING LEGISLATION & TITLE

This regulation is adopted pursuant to Section 5 of Village law Number 1 of 2002, Section 1640(a)(6) of the New York State Vehicle & Traffic law and Section 20-2002 of the New York State Village Law, and shall be known as Vehicle & Traffic Regulation Number 6 of the Village of Greenwich. This regulation may be cited as "VOG VTL 6." This regulation repeals and replaces Village of Greenwich Ordinances "Section 12" and "Section 12 Amendment".

SECTION 2

SNOW EVENT PARKING REGULATIONS

2.1 The parking of motor vehicles on the streets of the Village of Greenwich is prohibited for 36 hours following a snowfall of one or more inches beginning at midnight following said snowfall and continuing for 36 hours thereafter. In the case of consecutive days where there is a snowfall of one inch or more, the 36 hour period of no parking shall begin anew at midnight following each snowfall of one inch or more. Any violation of this regulation shall be punishable by a fine of \$25.00 and shall be subject to any other remedy provided by Section 5 of Village law Number 1 of 2002.

SECTION 3

POSTING OF REGULATIONS

The Superintendent of Public Works of the Village of Greenwich is hereby directed to obtain official signs conforming to the Uniform Traffic Control Device Manual and the Regulations of the New York State Department of Transportation, and to post said signs at such places upon or along the streets of the Village of Greenwich as may be necessary to advise motorists of the Regulations herein above enacted; or, in the alternative, obtain written authorization from the New York State Department of Transportation to provide notice of this parking regulation by publishing such notices in the official newspaper of the Village of Greenwich as required by the Department.

SECTION 4

EFFECTIVE DATE

These Regulations shall take effect on the date that signs have been posted or written authorization for providing notice by publication has been received in accordance with Section 3 of this Regulation, except that with respect to State Highways within the Village, this Regulation shall not take effect until written approval from the New York State Department of Transportation has been obtained.
