

Minutes Special Meeting

April 30, 2019

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwich was held on April 30, 2019 in the Board Room of the Community Center at 6 Academy Street in the Village of Greenwich. Present were Mayor Fuller, Attorney Kelly and Trustees Brown, Robinson, Edsforth and Vandewater. Mayor Fuller opened the meeting at 6:00 PM. Chief White joined the meeting late.

Public Hearing:

Mayor Fuller opened the meeting with the Public Hearing on proposed Local Law No. 2 entitled "A Local Law to Prohibit Smoking, Vaping and Chewing Tobacco on Certain Village Property." No comment from the public was made. Trustee Brown made a motion to close the hearing, seconded by Trustee Edsforth and carried by all. Attorney Kelly pointed out that the law was difficult to enforce without signs. Mayor Fuller assured the group that signs would be posted around the Village Hall within the week. Mayor Fuller asked for a Resolution to pass this law. Trustee Brown made a motion to pass Local Law No. 2, seconded by Trustee Vandewater and carried by all.

Old Business

Passing the 2019/20 Budget; it is unchanged since the last meeting. A resolution to adopt the 2019-20 budget was made on a motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Edsforth, and carried by all present.

Chief White presented the Board with the repair bill for Engine 323. A resolution to approve \$3587.20 to pay for Engine 323 repair from Fire Department Capital Equipment Reserve, subject to permissive referendum was made on a motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Edsforth and carried by all.

- VFW Memorial Day Parade permit for Friday, May 24 at 6pm was approved on a motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Edsforth and carried by all.

The Meeting was adjourned at on a motion from Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Edsforth, and carried by all.
