Former water reservoir for the Village of Greenwich


Deeded to the Village in 1957

The access lane to the Village of Greenwich Thunder Mountain Recreation Area is located on the North Road in Greenwich, NY.

From the start of North Road at the intersection of Gray Avenue and Prospect Street in the village of Greenwich go approximately 1 mile to a gravel lane on the right side of North Road. There is a red metal gate. (If you pass Derby Road you have gone too far.)

The access lane is the village's right-of-way. Follow the lane up the hill to the parking area.
