Minutes November 9, 2022 Special Meeting

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwich held a special meeting. Present were Mayor Fuller, and Trustees Brown, Robinson, Panza, Vandewater and Attorney Kelly.

Mayor Fuller opened the meeting at 7:06pm.

Allen Forestry Final Plan – Jim Allen presented his final plans along with timber volume sale report estimates.

Plan 1 – 5992 Trees, 714,225 total board feet, 759 cords. Approximately 125 acres are marked. Unmarked areas include buffer zone around the reservoir, parking area, and a section north of the power lines. This section is a healthier plantation then the rest of the property. The value sheet is broken down by low, average and high current values. There is a lot of volatility in the market with fuel, parts, interest rates going up and the housing market starting to decline. The average value is what the Village could hope to expect now. The values are estimated to decline next summer as shown on table 2 of each plan.
